 Core inflation 2: Core inflation 1 less public services



Price of imported goods in the CPI and import-weighted exchange rate of the króna



Consumer prices: goods



Contribution to inflation in past 1, 3, 6 and 12 months



Consumer prices: housing and services



 national CPI inflation for USA, Switzerland and Japan



Food, groceries and petrol prices




Economic growth and national expenditure



Turnover based on VAT returns: selected sectors



Consumption and gross fixed capital formation



In real terms (deflated by the price of groceries in the CPI)



Exports and imports of goods and services



Change on same period in previous year, deflated using the CPI for domestic turnover and the exchange rate for turnover abroad



Turnover based on VAT returns











Merchandise imports and exports



Merchandise trade balance








Wage index and real wages







In real terms, based on 4-month moving averages





In real terms, based on 4-month moving averages



Monthly turnover and daily equity prices on ICEX (latest: April 22, 2005)



Quarterly, inflation-adjusted prices



Price per m² in Greater Reykjavík Area, 3-month moving averages




Quarterly credit system lending growth



Base money and repurchase agreements with the Central Bank



Household debt with main credit institutions



The Central Bank repo rate and interbank interest rates



Credit to domestic sector, excluding marketable securities



Short-term interest rates and interest rate spread



Growth of M3 and DMBs' credit to domestic sector




April 22, 2005



between bank indexed lending rates and T-bond real yield



Latest: March 18



Indexed bank rates: lending rates and deposit rates



Non-indexed interest rates: average bank lending rates, the yield on T-bonds and the policy interest rate



December 31, 1991=100



Indexed interest rates: average bank lending rates and real yield on housing bonds and T-bonds


