
I-5 Prices of imported goods and exchange rate development Import-weighted exchange rate of the króna and prices of imported goods in the CP




1-6 Components of CPI inflation Contribution to inflation in past 12 months



Inflation in Iceland and trading partner countries HICP inflation for all countries except national CPI inflation for USA, Switzerland and Japan




I-8 Inflation expectations Breakeven inflation rate at month-end and inflation expectations according to surveys










II-5 Turnover based on VAT returns Seasonally adjusted




Groceries turnover In real terms (deflated by the price of groceries in the CPI)




Consumption and gross fixed capital formation Quarterly data





Payment card turnover Deflated by the CPI less housing cost for domestic turnover and the exchange rate for turnover abroad









Merchandise exports by category




3-month moving averages, export value at fixed exchange rates








Private sector wage index by sector

Private sector wage index by occupational group







Regular revenues excluding asset sales, regular expenditure excluding interest 4-month moving averages in real terms








Treasury expenditures by type 4-month moving averages in real terms



Monthly turnover and equity prices





Price per m², 3-month moving averages






Commercial property prices in Greater Reykjavík Weighted average of industrial, retail and office premises





Household debt with main credit institutions Monthly data






Growth of M3 and DMB's credit to domestic sector Monthly data


Base money and repurchase agreements with the Central Bank




Central Bank policy interest rate in real terms Weekly data






Bank lending rates, T-note yields and policy interest rate


Bank lending rates and real yield on housing bonds and T-bonds


