




1-1 Consumer price inflation and core inflation¹




I-3 Components of CPI inflation Contribution to inflation in past 12 months















III-4 Merchandise imports and exports 12- and 3-month moving averages, at fixed exchange rates










Seasonally adjusted merchandise imports


Merchandise exports by category

Percentage change on a year earlier



Percentage change on a year earlier





In real terms deflated by CPI





V-8 Treasury expenditures by function 4-month moving averages in real terms





VI-2 Residential housing prices in Greater Reykjavík Price per m², 3-month moving averages




Residential housing in Greater Reykjavík





Weighted average of industrial, retail and office premises




Market price of residential housing Entire country and regional Iceland





DMB credit to companies Contribution to credit growth








Base money and repurchase agreements with the Central Bank


Average nominal interest rates

Bank lending rates, T-note yields and policy interest rate






VII-23 Nominal and real effective exchange rate of the króna Monthly averages





Bank lending rates and real yield on housing bonds and T-bonds





Bank lending and deposit rates Indexed terms





CDSs of Icelandic banks and Itraxx Financial Index Daily data July 8, 2006 - March 25, 2008





Carry-to-risk ratio and forward currency position of the commercial banks Monthly data






