


I-3 Components of CPI inflation Contribution to inflation in past 12 months





I-8 Inflation expectations Breakeven inflation rate at month-end and inflation expectations according to surveys




II-6 Turnover based on VAT returns Seasonally adjusted



II-7 Turnover based on VAT returns Selected sectors




II-8 Groceries turnover In real terms (deflated by the price of groceries in the CPI)










II-14 Consumer sentiment (Gallup) Index, current situation and expectations six months ahead




Components of current account

Net current transfer is included in factor income




Merchandise imports and exports








Seasonally adjusted merchandise imports







3-month moving averages, export value at fixed exchange rates





Private sector wage index by sector




Private sector wage index by occupational group



V-8 Treasury expenditures by function 4-month moving averages in real terms






Commercial property prices in Greater Reykjavík





DMB credit to companies Contribution to credit growth












Forward interest rates based on swap agreements

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
Average nominal interest rates Bank lending rates, T-note yields and policy interest rate


Interest rate spreads


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Nominal and real effective exchange rate of the króna Monthly averages





Average indexed interest rates Bank lending rates and real yield on housing bonds and T-bonds




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Bank lending and deposit rates Indexed terms








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
Carry-to-risk ratio and forward currency position of the commercial banks Monthly data




